- Highlight the richness and uniqueness of the Pyrenees' biodiversity.
- Raise awareness of the risks posed by the effects of climate change at local and global levels.

- Identify the causes and consequences of climate change on biodiversity loss in the Pyrenees.
- Recognise the effects of climate change on phenological cycles and inter-species relationships.
- Value the ecosystem services provided by the Pyrenean environment (health, food, water, forests, etc.).
- Propose changes in habits and behaviours to address the climate emergency.
- Contribute to preserving natural heritage and promoting biodiversity.
- Engage the public to act in ways that benefit the environment, by collecting data on the effects of climate change in the Pyrenees.
- Facilitate access to educational resources on the consequences of climate change in the Pyrenees.
